Stokesia laevis

lilacblue aug- oct 30-45cm
cornflower
full sun and half shade
fertile soil pervious to water
likes a warm and limy soil



Phlomis tuberoza 'Bronze Flamingo'

Lavender pink june-july 100cm
with dark stems
dry condition tolerance ,full sun
easy and reliable



Delphinium (P) 'Summer Skies'

vivid blue june-sept 140 cm
attractive lakspur-delphinium
fertile soil pervious to water
for clusters in the border
in combination with other high
perennials and ornamental grasses



Campanula lactiflora 'Prichard's Variety'

amethyst violet blue july-aug 80cm
gratefull borderplant
humide , fertile pervious to water
soil , for sun and mid-shade.



Lavandula angustifolia 'Schola'(Blue Cushion)

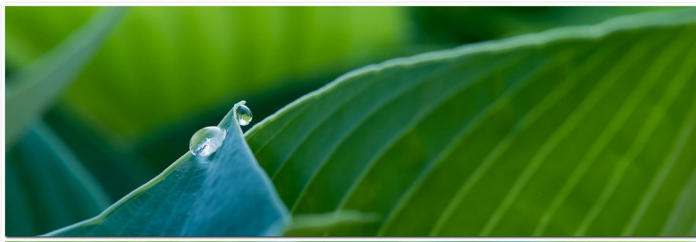
violet blue june-sept 30 cm
very flowering and nice compact
full sun , dry soil.



Centaurea montana 'Coerulea'

blue mountain cornflower
attract butterflies
preference humide humus soil
but also dry and limy tolerant.





It is just one of the big charms the fact that Perennials disappear and pop up and surprise us each year again with very fresh , colourfull and powerfull growth , nevertheless each year different !

Beside the flowers , Hosta are very usefull as a leafplant . Beside the green and colourfull spotted and variegated varieties , we have a few with soft and tender blue shades .

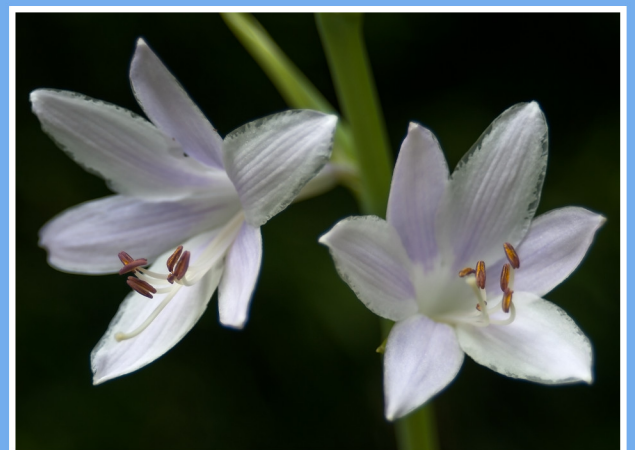
Their big large leaves combine well with ferns , who also do surprise us with their curly spring shoots.

As shadeplants Hosta fits to combine with Rodgersia varieties
Polygonatum (Solomon's Seal)
Epimedium (Barrenwort)
all with soft colours , they provide very subtile uplighting atmosphere in the shade garden.

Beside : Hosta fortunei 'Hyacinthina'

Under : a not to be despised , fragrant Hosta plantaginea grandiflora

Geranium 'Orion'

pure blue june-september
50cm , powerfull, healthy grow
even in heavy soil
good combinationplant
for boxplanting and in the border
as a plant to weave in between.
= sterile (do not seed)
for open places and wood-edge



Geranium 'Rozanne'

syn Geranium 'Gerwat'
suitable for any gardensoil
large growing even half climbing
you will need only 3 à 4 pl/m²
very long flowering ,
a delight from june-nov.
weaving in between other high
perennials and shrubs.
+- 40 cm



Geranium sylvaticum

woodland cranesbill
strong perennial , grow best in
semi-shaded woodland gardens
june- july + second flower in aug
rich red-violet-blue
creeping rhizome
